Pre Test and Course Preparation

The American Heart Association 2020 Guidelines for PALS has resulted in a change in the way courses are presented. Students are **REQUIRED** to complete both an online Self-Assessment and precourse work. Please allow plenty of time to complete this work prior to attending class. **You must bring your completion certificate with you to class.** If you do not bring the certificate, we are unable to admit you to class and you will not be eligible for rescheduling or a refund.

AHA will not display the certificate until you have completed the course survey. If you cannot find the certificate, please look for the survey and complete it online.


If you do not already have an account with AHA you can register on the site. The precourse does offer possible CE/CME credits depending on your professional requirements.

BLS Certification


